Who are the Daley Debutantes?

The Daley Debutantes are a talented and confident group of 100-plus young people ranging in age from 4 to 25. Senior, Junior, and Juvenile baton twirlers; rifle units, banner carriers, color guard and musicians including drummers, marching bells, and cymbals - the Daley Debs bring together an astounding TEAM of whom it can truly be said: "The whole is even greater than the sum of its parts."

Today, the Daley Debutantes are the oldest, largest, and most celebrated baton corps in Wisconsin. After more than 1,000 parades and numerous world, national, and state titles, the Corps celebrated its 50th anniversary in 2005. Founded by Sherry Daley, who continues to direct the Corps with sisters Marcy and Patti, the Daley Debutantes made their first public appearance in the West Allis Fourth of July Parade in 1955. Since then, the Orange-and-Green of "The Daleys" have become a familiar and much anticipated sight at Chicago's and Milwaukee's St. Patrick's Day Parades, as well as Fourth of July, Veterans Day, Memorial Day, and Christmas Parades throughout southeastern Wisconsin, and the annual South Shore Water Frolic, St. Francis Days, Irish Fest, West Allis Western Days, and Wisconsin State Fair.

The Daley Debutantes Baton & Drum Corps participates in competitions at the local, state, national, and international levels. They have performed at college football's Gator Bowl and Kickoff Classic, and have marched in Dublin, Ireland's St. Patrick's Day Parade in 1999 and 2003. Their winning tradition has culminated in 21 Grand World Parade Corps, 35 National Parade Corps, and 50 Wisconsin State Parade Corps titles. Most recently, at "America's Youth on Parade" at Notre Dame University last July, the Daley Debutantes won the 2009 Grand World Parade Corps Championship for Corps with Live Music.
